

## **Michael McManus Elected To Illinois Hospital Association Board of Trustees**

Michael McManus, Chief Operating Officer, Touchette Regional Hospital, has been elected to the Illinois Hospital Association's (IHA) Board of Trustees. McManus will begin serving a three-year term on the IHA Board on Jan. 1, 2012.

McManus has over 25 years experience working in the health care industry. As Chief Operating Officer of Touchette Regional Hospital since 2006, McManus oversees the 127 bed facility with over 700 employees. He has been a member of the IHA Board of Trustees since 2010 and serves on several other boards including Midwest Stone Institute Board of Directors.

The IHA Board of Trustees is the Association's policymaking body. The Board is made up of 32 trustees, including 14 at-large trustees elected by the voting members of the Association, nine regional trustees elected directly by the regions, six elected officers (chairman, chairman-elect, immediate past chairman, immediate past, past chairman, treasurer, and secretary), and the Association's president ex officio. Constituency sections, councils and ad hoc task forces provide members with opportunities to participate in the Association's policy development process.
